Modification of the time of the visit

Visitors may change the previously booked time slots without extra fee of charge until the day prior to the visit by using the administrative interface. We are not able to refund the cost of admission fee upon cancellation in this case.

Cancellation by the Parliament

The visit can be cancelled due to programs of the Parliament or state protocol events even directly before the visit. The Office of the National Assembly release the information of cancellation on the website and on the booking system interface within the shortest possible time. If you have submitted an e-mail address during your registration, you will be informed via e-mail as well. In this case the already paid admission fees will be reimbursed.

Important information

1. Upon entering the Parliament, you are kindly requested to produce nationality documents and proof of eligibility for any discounts.
2. Tickets can be purchased at the ticket office either in cash (Hungarian forints (HUF)) or by bank/credit card.
3. Parliament is accessible to people with disabilities. Please request assistance from our staff at the ticket office or entrance gate.
4. Apart from guide dogs, no other animals are permitted inside the Building.
5. For the protection of the Holy Crown, it is strictly forbidden to take pictures in the great Dome Hall. However, taking pictures or using video cameras is allowed in other parts of the Building.
6. Please ask for cloakrooms or left luggage lockers in the Visitor Center.
7. Lavatories for visitors are at the Visitor Center.
8. Due to parliamentary or state events, visits may be cancelled even as late as immediately prior to admission.
9. Cars and coaches cannot park in front of the Parliament Building.

Behavioural and dressing code

The dignity of the Building requires all visitors to have cultured dressing code. It is forbidden:

- to wear or use totalitarian symbols, to behave as to injure the national value and dignity of the National Assembly, the Holy Crown, and the coronation jewels, or to infringe human dignity;

- to take in flags, demonstration signs, tools into the Building;
- to present noisy and overbearing behaviour, to sing, to held demonstration;
- to eat, drink and to smoke;
- to sit, to kneel or to lay down on the staircase, on the floor or on the furniture, to cause any damage in the furniture;
- to disturb, to hinder the work of organisations or persons working in the Building on any way;
- to take in any kind of noisemaking tools (e.g. whistle or loudspeaker).

Visitors are kindly asked to cooperate with the Guards, or with any employees of the Parliament. Visitors failed to keep the regulation of visiting the Parliament will be ushered out of the Building by the Guards
